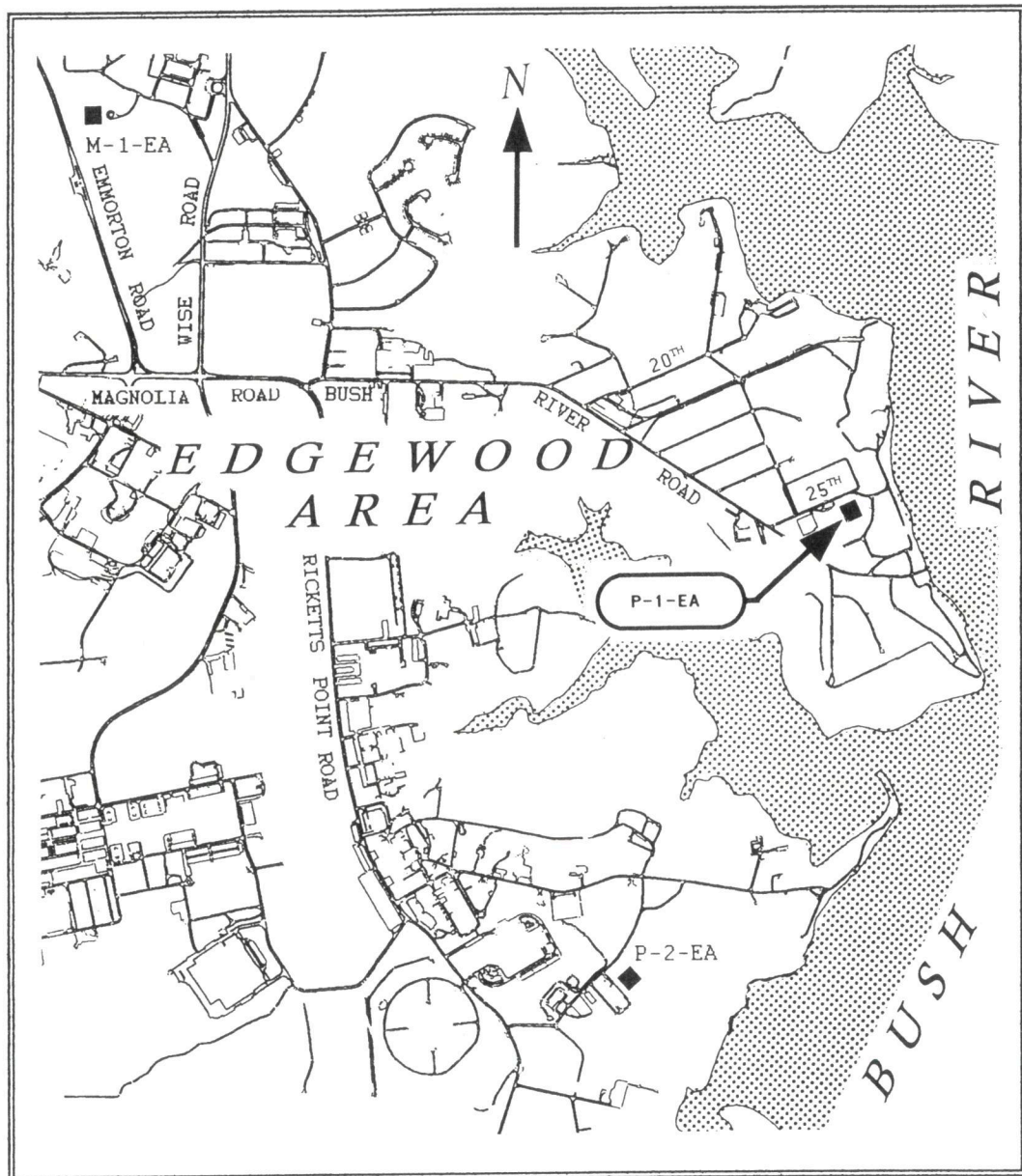



ABERDEEN PROVING GROUND

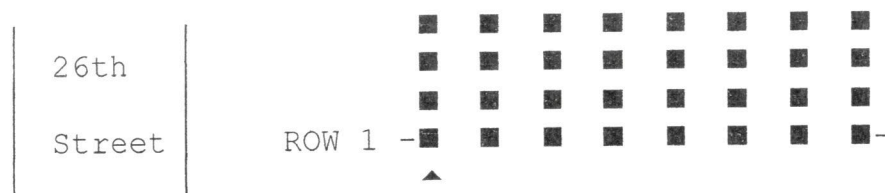
Road Sign Directions

South on Emmorton Road (MD 24) from the Main Gate (APG
Edgewood Entry Control) 0.3 miles to Magnolia Road.
Left on Magnolia Road 0.4 miles to the intersection
with Ricketts Point Road. Turn left onto Bush River
Road. Straight on Bush River Road 1.3 miles to 25th
Street. Left on 25th Street 1000 feet. Cemetery is on
the right.

Notes: Jon Harlan Livezey
records the stones of John Wesley Day and
Goldsmith Day at the 'Day Cemetery', located
at the Gun Club, Edgewood Arsenal.

[The stones have been relocated to this
cemetery (PRIVATE CEMETERY P-1-EA), but
whether or not the graves were relocated
is unknown.]
