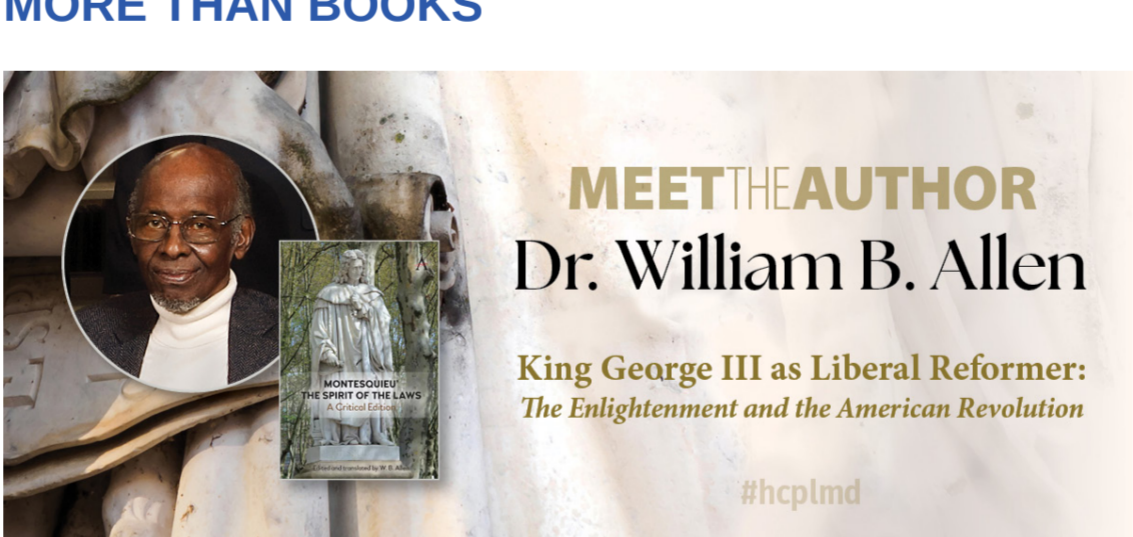
The Black Arts Movement
