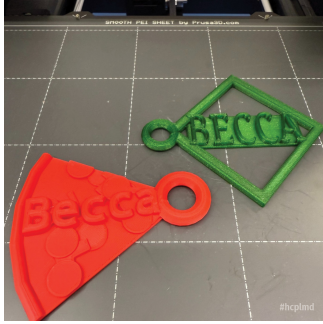

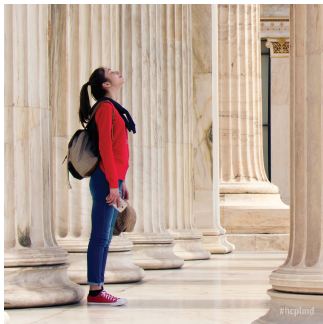
Intro to 3D Design
