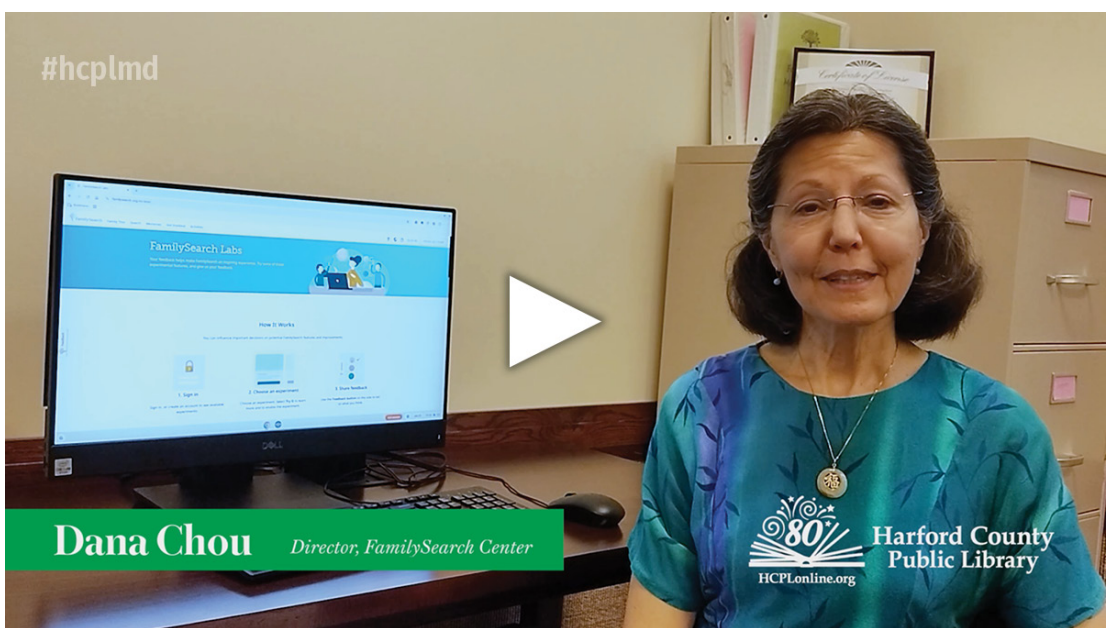

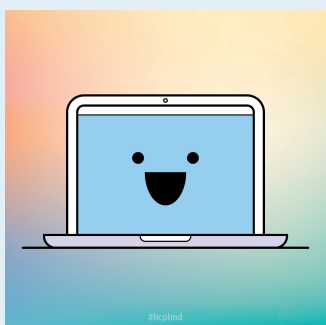

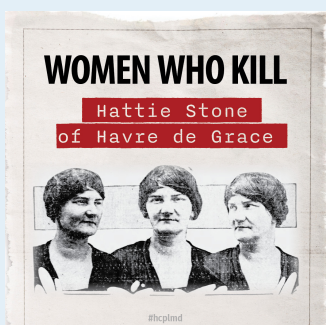
Computers for Beginners
